

2010 Annual Winter Business Meeting Ohio Chapter of the American Fisheries Society Fawcett Center Assembly Hall, Columbus, OH 4:00-5:00 pm, 5 February 2010

- 1) Call to Order and Determination of Quorum 19 members present.
- 2) Welcome by President Nick Radabaugh Stressed the importance of attending the annual business meeting.
- 3) AFS Presentation: Gwen White, NCD Representative Want to engage with chapters but the weather prevented her attendance.
- 4) Officer Reports
 - President: Nick Radabaugh The Buckeye Student Subunit was certified by AFS. Updated the OCAFS Strategic Plan. Had a successful summer meeting with the yellow perch bait study.
 - ii) President-Elect: Curt Wagner Deferred to later in the meeting.
